
PONY LEAGUE RULES

1. Length of games will remain at 1 hour and 45 minutes or 7 innings. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 45 minutes.
2. Re-entry rule will be used during regular season and tournament play. Any player can leave the game but upon re-entry, he must re-enter in the same spot in the batting order, but he can play another position.
3. Once a pitcher is removed from the mound, he cannot return to pitch in that game.
4. Pitchers can pitch 10 innings per week only. He cannot pitch more than 7 innings in one calendar day.
5. Each team will furnish a Pony League Insignia Ball for each game.
6. It is recommended that every player play in every game. With proper understanding of re-entry rules, we can make this a positive experience for the less gifted players.
7. Every team may start or continue the game with 7 players. The outs are recorded when their place comes to bat.
8. Ten minutes grace period before forfeit. Time will be taken off your game time in the event of a late start due to the lack of a complete team.
9. Ten minutes will be allowed between games.
10. Ten (10) run rule will prevail after 5 innings.
11. Each team will keep a score book with the home team being the official book. The official scorekeeper will be identified prior to the start of the game.
12. A coin flip will determine home team. The umpire will flip the coin.
13. The designated hitter rule is optional. He can bat anywhere in the order. The player he replaces will be listed 10th in the scorebook and his position. You can pitch-hit for the D.H. The player that he replaces, in other words, the number 10 man in the score book can also hit for the D.H. This is a league rule only, therefore it will not be used in tournament play.
14. A protest can be made in writing to the Directors on rule interpretations only.
15. Winning coaches must call in the score to the Logan Recreation Center at 750-9877, between the hours of 10am to 11am. the day after the game.
16. Rain out games and incomplete games are to be rescheduled by both coaches. They must arrange for park facilities and call Larry Jacobsen at the numbers on the front sheet. Incomplete games will resume where game was left off.
17. Two minutes or five warm up pitches will be allowed between each inning. The high school speed-up rule may be used for the pitcher and the catcher.
18. If your city has two or more teams, you must hold a draft. Remember only seven 14 year olds can be on one team. If your city has only one team there is no limit to the amount of 14 year olds.
19. All managers are expected to follow the instruction on the pitching sheet and the team log sheet.
20. All coaches are expected to abide by the general conduct rules in the Pony rule book.
21. Because of insurance requirements, all fees must be paid by May 1st.
