

Parade Information

2020 Health Days Celebration – Saturday, May 9th @ 10:00 am

The parade on Main Street will begin at 10:00 am and end at approximately 11:00 am. We invite you to help us make this year's parade the best yet. All parade entries must be approved but anyone is welcome to submit an entry form. Entrance to the parade is free.

Line-Up

Check-in and staging will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 9th. Entry numbers will not be assigned before you arrive; however, you will have a designated area where you'll need to line up. Entrants will line up on an organized FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE basis. Please be flexible and patient as your floats and vehicles are lined up. We are only allowed to close Main Street from 9-11 a.m. This means we won't have very much time to get all lined up so **it is crucial you arrive on time.**

Loading

There will be very limited space in the staging and drop off area so if at all possible please meet in the Sky View High School parking lot to load up and then head over to Main Street. If you have walkers, you can drop them off at the designated area on Main Street. **Please carpool as much as possible to avoid congestion in the staging area.**

To enter the staging area from Sky View, you will need to go north on 250 East, then left heading west on 400 South, and turn right on Main Street. Once on Main Street, you will use the middle lane to travel north and turn right onto 300 South. You may drop off walkers on 300 South between Main Street and 100 East but please carpool to the drop-off zone.

If you are parking a vehicle while participating in the parade, please park in the middle section of the south parking lot at Sky View High School.

Drop-off

To enter the drop-off zone you will need to enter on Main Street at the 400 South intersection. Use the middle lane to travel north and turn right on 300 South. You may drop off walkers on 300 South between Main Street and 100 East. To exit, continue east to 100 East. The staging and drop-off areas will be very busy so please drive carefully and unload quickly to avoid congestion.

Where To Start

All parade participants must enter Main Street at 400 South at no earlier than 9:00 a.m. Again, we aren't given very much time so please be prompt because we will start the parade on time.

Parade Route

The parade route will travel from 300 South to 300 North. In the interest of time, no parade participants are to stop along the parade route to distribute flyers or perform routines. Please also try to avoid large gaps before or after you. Smithfield City Police will monitor the parade route to ensure compliance.

Safety

This is our highest priority. Only those 12 years and older may throw candy and only those 18 years and older may distribute flyers along the route. Please throw candy towards the curb. Instruct those 12 and older who are throwing candy to throw it as far away from your vehicle as possible. **Please do not start throwing candy until you have completely exited the staging area.**

Conduct

We expect all parade entries to be respectful, courteous, and safe; this may include the parade vehicle, printed material, or participants. The participant may be asked to withdraw from the parade and may not be allowed to participate in the future if any part of the parade entry is deemed to be disrespectful, offensive, vulgar, or unsafe. This may also include not throwing candy far enough away from the parade vehicle.

De-Staging

The parade route ends at the intersection of Main Street and 300 North. All parade entries, **excluding children's groups and walkers**, should exit the parade route by turning east on 300 North. All groups with children or walkers can unload on Main Street between 300 and 400 South. Parents will need to pick up children no later than 10:50 a.m. because we are required to open up the road again at 11:00 a.m.

During the unloading stage, the Smithfield Lions Club will be handing out Creamies to all participants. Please help us keep the parade going by moving along quickly to avoid a bottleneck.

Registration

Entry forms must be completed – signed and dated – and submitted no later than **Thursday, April 30th by 5:00 pm**. Entry forms received after this date will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Entry forms can be submitted via
