



Dress Code & Safety within the Recreation Center

The Smithfield Community Recreation Center was established to promote healthy lifestyles for families in our community. Members and patrons play a key role in supporting a safe and welcoming environment within the center.

Clothing that is revealing; clothing that is intimidating or offensive to the point of likely causing a disruption; as well as clothing that may present safety hazards, damage flooring/equipment, is not allowed. Items in this category include but are not limited to:

- Clothing designed to be undergarments
 - String tank tops that do not cover the torso
 - Open-toed shoes, sandals, or shoes that will mark the floor
 - Jeans/pants with prominent grommets or belts
 - Clothing with messaging that will likely cause a substantial disruption
 - Greasy or soiled shoes/clothing

- Capped water bottles only.
 - Personal belongings, bags, and any clothing not in use must be kept in lockers or storage holders.
